Political Action Fund Application Grassroots political action or training, & election campaign training

This application form should be used by members seeking support to:

- 1) engage in grassroots political action;
- 2) attend training to enable them to engage in grassroots political action; or
- 3) attend election campaign training.

HSA will advertise these opportunities as they become available. Members may also request support to participate in action or training they become aware of that has not been advertised by HSA. Please see the criteria for support listed below.

1. Grassroots political action

Members may apply for Political Action Fund support to engage in approved grassroots political action, which meets the following 4 criteria:

- 1) the issue and activity are non-partisan;
- 2) the issue and activity advance 1 or more of HSA's constitutional objects & purposes;
- 3) the issue is a priority for HSA; and
- 4) HSA considers the type of action involved to be appropriate.

In general, activities involved in educating the public or decision-makers, advocating, lobbying, and organizing around an approved issue may be eligible for support.

Eligible issues include various labour or social justice issues, e.g., promoting public health care or community social services, anti-poverty initiatives, seniors' services etc.

Examples of actions which may be eligible for support include:

- 1) working on non-partisan campaigns coordinated by:
 - a) affiliated labour organizations (e.g. NUPGE, the BC Federation of Labour, the CLC); or
 - b) progressive, non-partisan community organizations such as the BC Health Coalition, Canadian Health Coalition, Council of Canadians, and ACORN;
- 2) organizing or helping with events (meetings, workshops, rallies, info tables)
- 3) writing or distributing materials (e.g., petitions, letters, information leaflets, educational materials)
- 4) meeting with elected officials and other decision-makers.

2. Grassroots political action training

Members may apply for Political Action Fund support to attend training to enable them to engage in approved grassroots political action (as outlined above).

Members may apply for the type of support usually provided to attend education, including wage replacement/banked time, travel, accommodation, tuition and other expenses.

3. Election campaign training

Members may apply for Political Action Fund support to attend election campaign training which is:

- a) non-partisan (e.g., the Canadian Women Voters Congress Women's Campaign School); or
- b) is offered by labour organizations with which HSA is affiliated (e.g., the BC Federation of Labour, the Canadian Labour Congress, labour councils etc); or
- c) is offered by political parties that meet all of HSA's 4 criteria, by demonstrating support for the following:
 - i) a positive role for the public sector;
 - ii) the principles of the Canada Health Act,
 - iii) free collective bargaining for public sector employees; and
 - iv) progressive occupational health and safety legislation.
