Participants will attend courses to help them build skills related to the labour movement, political and community organizing, and leadership skills.

In addition to coursework, attendees will be able to participate in a variety of outdoor activities and connect with other young workers from around the province.

Cost of the weekend is \$375, which includes bus transportation from Lonsdale Quay in North Vancouver, boat transport to Camp Jubilee, meals, courses, activities and accommodation. Deadline for registration is noon, Thursday, August 30th.
