The BC Federation of Labour offers two scholarships for attendance at the 2007 CLC Winter School:

The  **Debra Mills Scholarship** is intended for persons with disabilities to attend a one-week course.  **Donna Sheaves Memorial Scholarship** is for a union woman to attend the Women in Leadership course. Applicants must write a letter as outlined in the attached application form. **Women in Leadership (Week One)**

This course offers union women an opportunity to develop and enhance their leadership skills and knowledge in a variety of current and emerging labour issues. A major component of the course will cover communication and motivational skills that are important for women activists at all levels. Participants will leave the course ready to take an active role in their union.
