Community Social Services bargaining resumes next week

The union bargaining committee for community social services workers met this week to prepare for bargaining resuming next week.

Josef Rieder represents HSA at the bargaining table, with HSA bargaining team chair Lynn Kelsey. "We're looking forward to working with employers to reach a fair settlement that improves the working life and conditions of our members," he said. "We hope the employers are willing to actively participate in collective bargaining after almost a year of talks."

The Community Social Services Bargaining Association bargains on behalf of 15,000 unionized community-based social services workers in BC, including 800 HSA members. The BCGEU is the lead union at the table.
