In recognition of the need for educating new stewards in these areas, HSA is offering 3-day Basic Steward Training workshops at the HSA office as follows:

The focus of these training sessions is for new, inexperienced HSA chief, assistant or general stewards who have received no previous training from HSA.

- role of the steward
- advocacy skills
- leadership skills
- contract interpretation
- grievance handling
