# Reason for Policy:

To state whether the Board of Directors, President, Regional Directors, Chief Stewards, Members-at-Large, other Stewards, and HSA Staff may (subject to conditions), or must not, support a candidate seeking elected HSA office.

## **Policy Statements:**

- 1. Board of Directors
- 1.1 The Board of Directors shall not endorse a candidate for any elected HSA office.
- 2. President and Regional Directors
- 2.1 While a President or Regional Director may support a candidate, they shall not use union reimbursed time or union branded merchandise, or claim for reimbursement of related expenses\* to campaign for a candidate or for themselves.
- \* except as provided for in Election of President policy and Election of Regional Directors policy.
- 2.2 A President or Regional Director may campaign on their own time and, notwithstanding policy statement 2.1, may campaign during the HSA Convention for a candidate or for themselves.
- 3. Chief Stewards; Members-at-Large; other Stewards
- 3.1 While a Chief Steward, Member-at-Large, and other Stewards, may support a candidate, they shall not use union reimbursed time or union branded merchandise, or claim for reimbursement of related expenses\* to campaign for a candidate or for themselves.
- \* except as provided for in Election of President policy and Election of Regional Directors policy.

- 3.2 A Chief Steward, Member-at-Large, and other stewards may campaign on their own time and, notwithstanding policy statement 3.1, may campaign during the HSA Convention and Regional Meetings, for a candidate or for themselves.
- 4. Candidates' Access to Members at a Chapter Meeting and/or via a Bulletin Board
- 4.1 Should a Steward decide to make arrangements to (i) convene an HSA elections-related chapter meeting and/or (ii) post a candidate's materials on the HSA bulletin board, the Steward shall provide equal access to such a meeting or the bulletin board to all candidates seeking office in that particular election.
- 5. HSA Staff
- 5.1 HSA staff shall not support or oppose a candidate for any elected HSA office.
