Regions 4, 5 & 6 annual meeting set for September 13 in New Westminster

REGIONAL MEETING – Friday, September 13

HSA's Board of Directors is pleased to announce that this year's HSA Regional Meetings will be held in conjunction with the union's regular quarterly meeting of the Board of Directors, allowing all members of the board to be on hand to hear from union representatives in the Lower Mainland about issues affecting HSA members in their regions.

Regional meetings are an excellent forum for HSA members to review the issues and activities of the past year, and discuss the opportunities and challenges that lie ahead. This meeting will be co-chaired by Region 4 Director Joe Sebastian, Region 5 Director Carla Gibbons and Region 6 Director Nancy Hay. The agenda will include reports on the union's activities, and delegates to the meeting will report on and discuss issues affecting HSA members in their region.

All HSA members are encouraged to attend this regional meeting. However, only those members who have delegate status will be eligible for reimbursement of expenses. If you are interested in attending, please contact your Chief Steward. All registration applications must be approved by the Chief Steward.

This year, members in Region 4 and 6 will elect Members-at-Large who will begin their two-year term at the conclusion of the union's 2020 Annual Convention. Members-at-Large meet two or three times a year to serve on the union's committees and help set the direction and priorities for HSA. They are also delegates to HSA's annual convention.
