Region 6 annual meeting set for October 22 at New Westminster HSA office

REGIONAL MEETING – Thursday, October 22

Regional meetings are an excellent forum for HSA members to review the issues and activities of the past year, and discuss the opportunities and challenges that lie ahead. The meeting will be co-chaired by Region 4 Director – Joe Sebastian and Region 6 Director – Anita Bardal. The agenda will include the President's report on the union's activities, and delegates to the meeting will have an opportunity to report on and discuss issues affecting HSA members in their region.

This year, members in Region 6 will elect Members-at-Large who will begin their two-year term at the conclusion of the union's 2016 Annual Convention. Members-at-Large meet two or three times a year to serve on the union's committees and help set the direction and priorities for HSA. They are also delegates to HSA's annual convention.

All HSA members are encouraged to attend this regional meeting. However, only those members who have delegate status will be eligible for reimbursement of expenses. If you are interested in attending, please contact your chief steward. All registration applications must be approved by the chief steward.

Education Workshop Dates: November 2
