REGIONAL MEETING – Monday, October 6

Regional meetings are an excellent forum for HSA members to review the issues and activities of the past year, and discuss the opportunities and challenges that lie ahead. The meeting will be co-chaired by Region 3 Director Bruce MacDonald and Region 7 Director Marg Beddis. The agenda will include the President's report on the union's activities, and delegates to the meeting will have an opportunity to report on and discuss issues affecting HSA members in their region.

This year, members in Regions 3 & 7 will elect Members-at-Large who will begin their two-year term at the conclusion of the union's 2015 Annual Convention.
