2021 - 2022 HSP Professional Development Fund Eligibility and Funding Guidelines April 2021

Eligibility:

- 1. The applicant must be an HSA member covered by the Health Science Professionals Bargaining Association contract.
- 2. Courses being applied for must start between April 1, 2021 and March 31, 2022.
- 3. The course must relate to professional development in a health science discipline being practiced in the public health care system.
- 4. Applications will be accepted until the fund is fully exhausted.

Funding Guidelines:

- 5. Subject to availability and once an application is approved, the fund will reimburse the cost of tuition/registration fees, books, and related travel expenses to a maximum of \$1,000.
- 6. Multiple Applications can be submitted for separate courses, but the fund is limited to \$1,000 per member.
- 7. Costs must be listed on application in Canadian Funds.
- 8. Add on fees relating to program registration costs, such as "Administrative", "Student", or "Technology" are <u>not</u> eligible.
- 9. Wage replacement is not covered.
- 10. Travel and accommodation expenses must be reasonable and fall within the HSA travel policy.
- 11. Meals will be covered up to per diem rates (\$20 per breakfast, \$25 per lunch & \$30 per dinner) as long as receipt is provided.
- 12. The applicant must disclose funding they have or will receive towards the course or program from any other source.
- 13. Successful applicants will be advised through their personal email when their application has been approved and the amount that has been awarded.
- 14. Successful applicants must provide receipts for all claimable expenses.
- 15. Payment will be made by electronic transfer (EFT) only from HSA once satisfactory documents have been received.
