Summer Institute for Union Women – Details Released for June 23-25, 2022 Virtual Conference

Details for the 2022 Summer Institute for Union Women have just been released by the BC Federation of Labour:

Registration for the [2022 Summer Institute for Union Women](#) (SIUW) has opened! This year's Institute will take place from Thursday, June 23 through Saturday, June 25. Attendees of this three-day virtual leadership institute will take part in skill-building workshops, cultural activities, political action and education sessions designed to expand their understanding of solidarity and build connections.

The SIUW includes leaders and activists from unions, labor studies programs, apprenticeships and worker organizations from across British Columbia, the Western United States, Hawaii, and Alaska. SIUW is for all our cis and trans union sisters, as well as our non-binary siblings who are comfortable in a space that centers the experiences of women.

HSA is excited to support members' participation by reimbursing the US\$50 registration cost, and wage-replacement scholarships are available for 11 members. To apply for an HSA scholarship, which covers the cost of registration and wage replacement, please email education@hsabc.org with your name, profession, worksite and a brief paragraph explaining why you wish to attend before 12:00 noon PST on Monday, June 6. **Members will be selected by random draw on Monday, June 6th and notified by email.**
